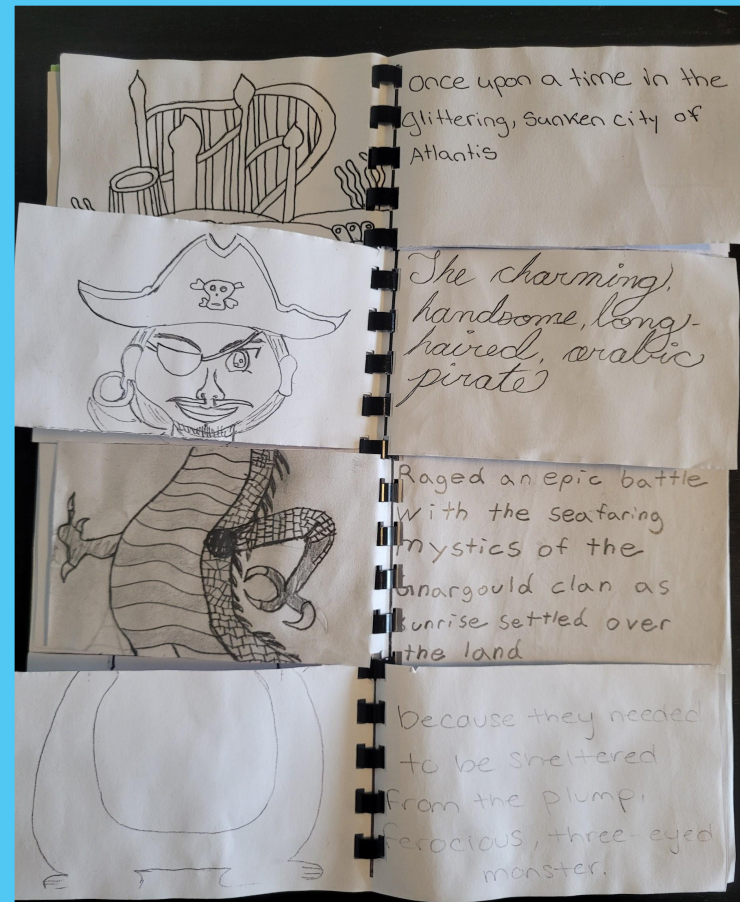
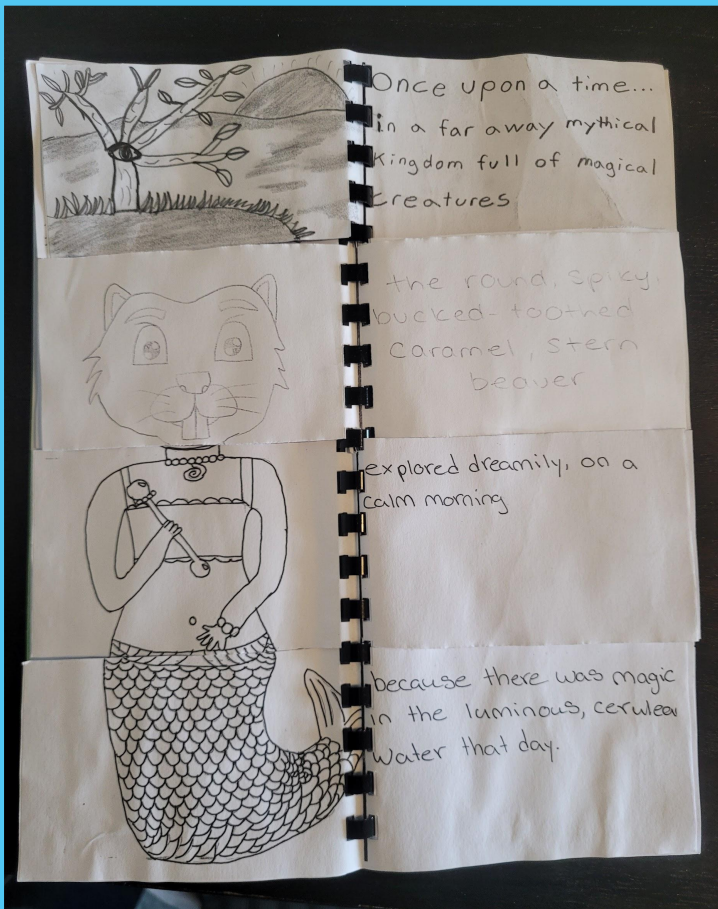

Collaborative books are for any grade, with the work done by the teacher decreasing as the grades get higher.

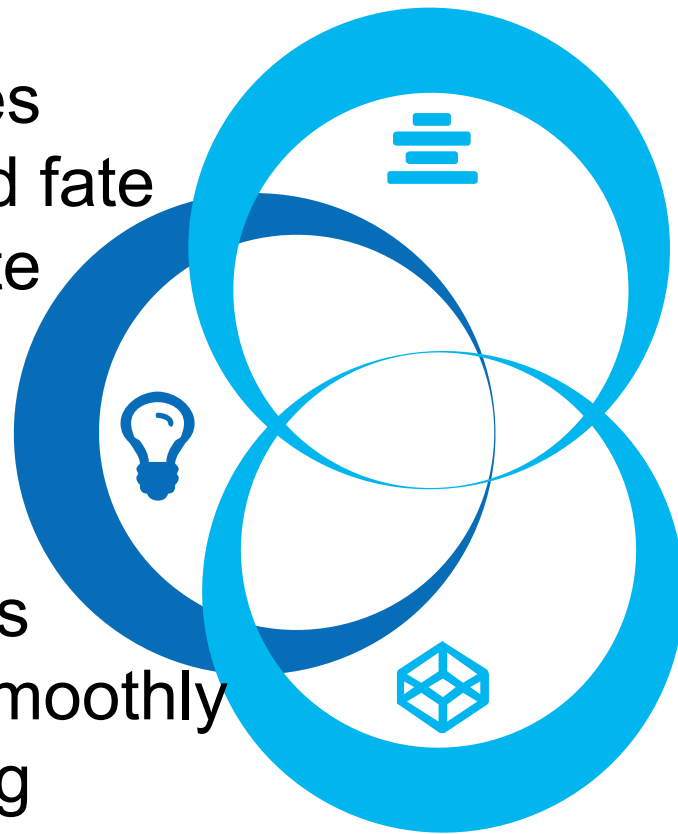


# Heiku

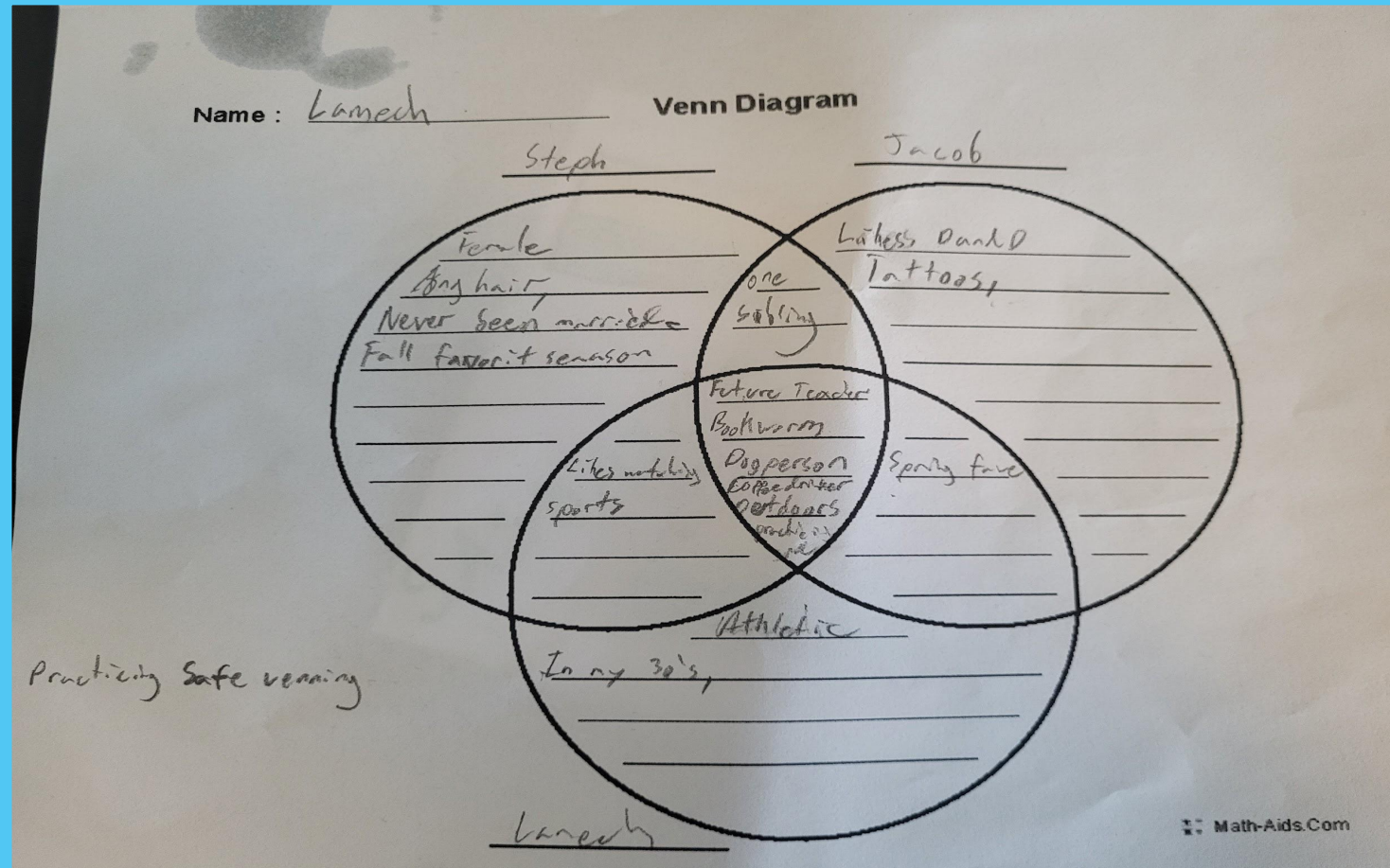


# Venn Diagrams

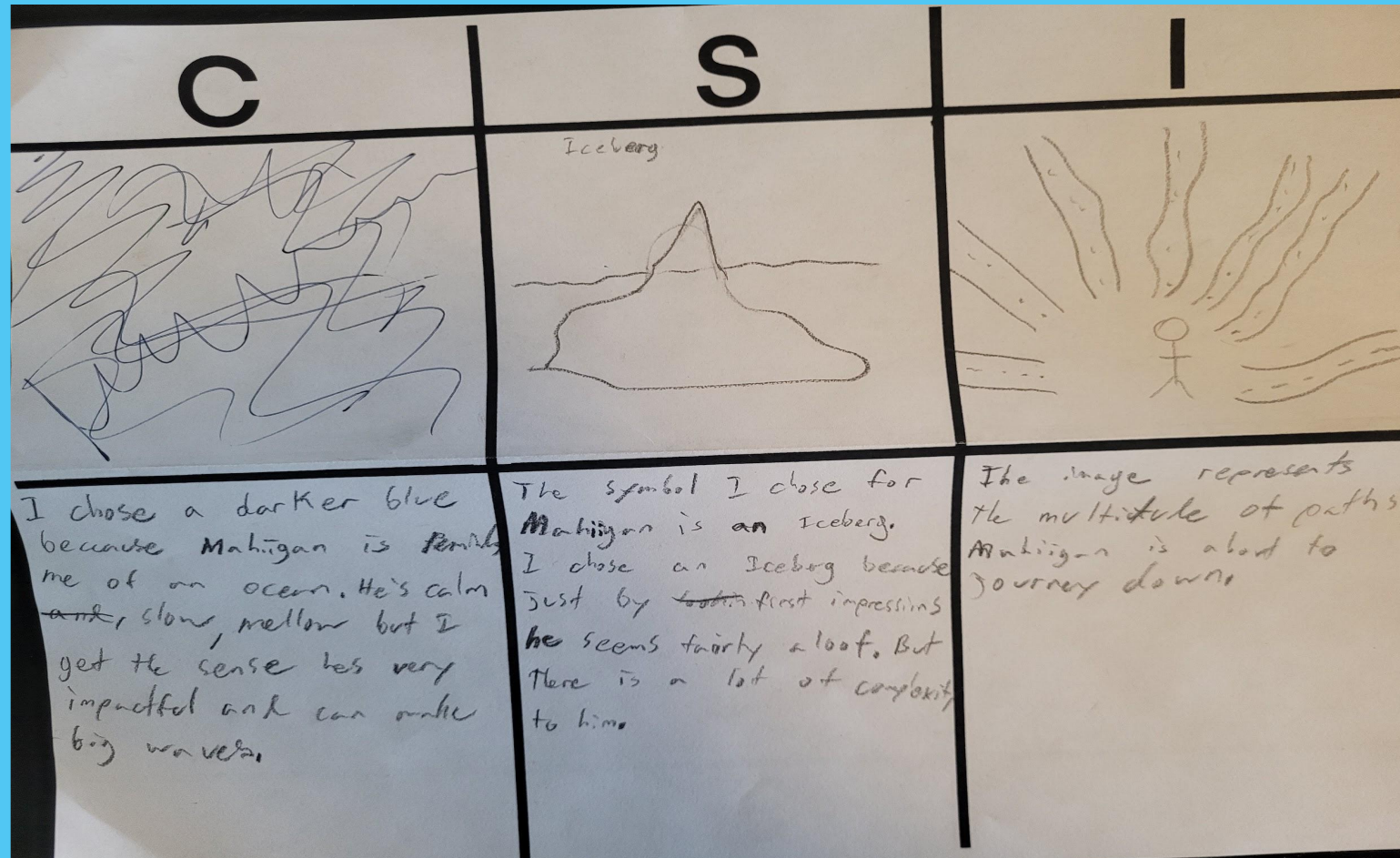

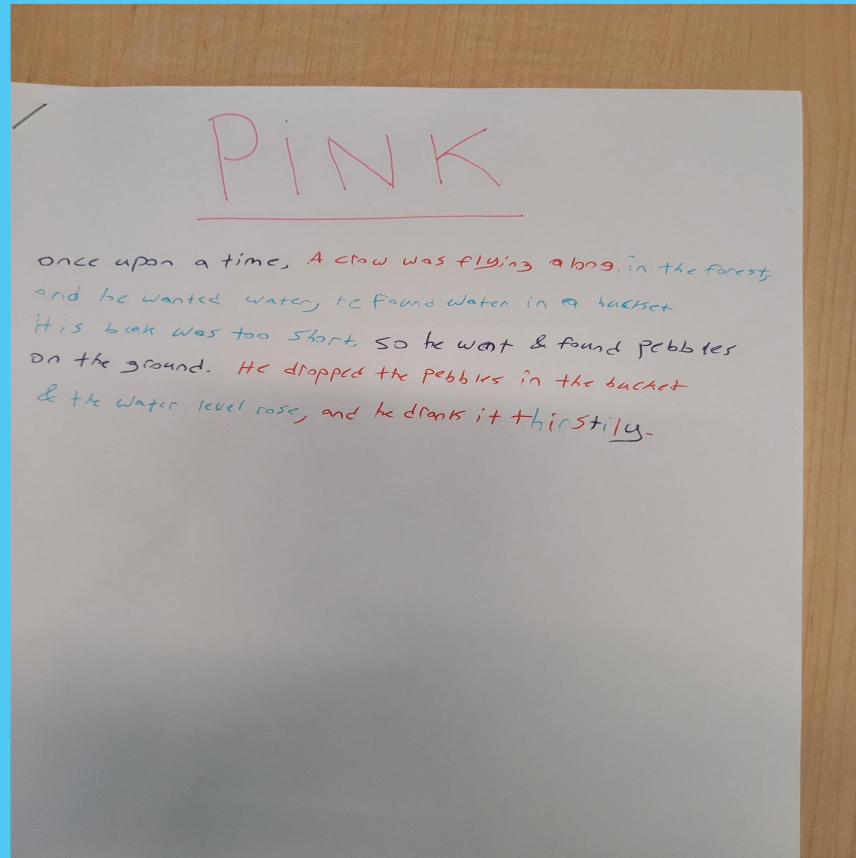


# Interactive Writing

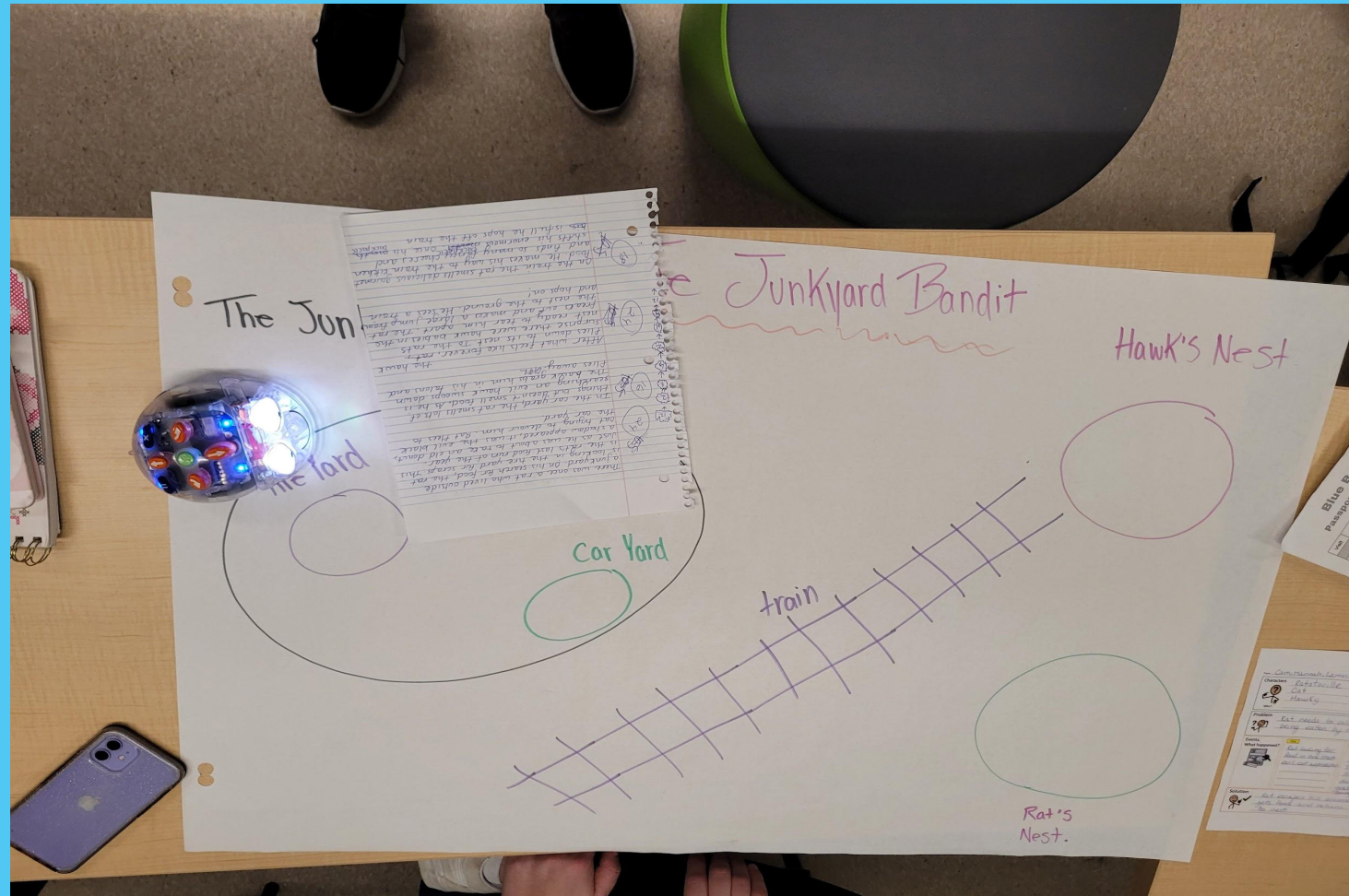

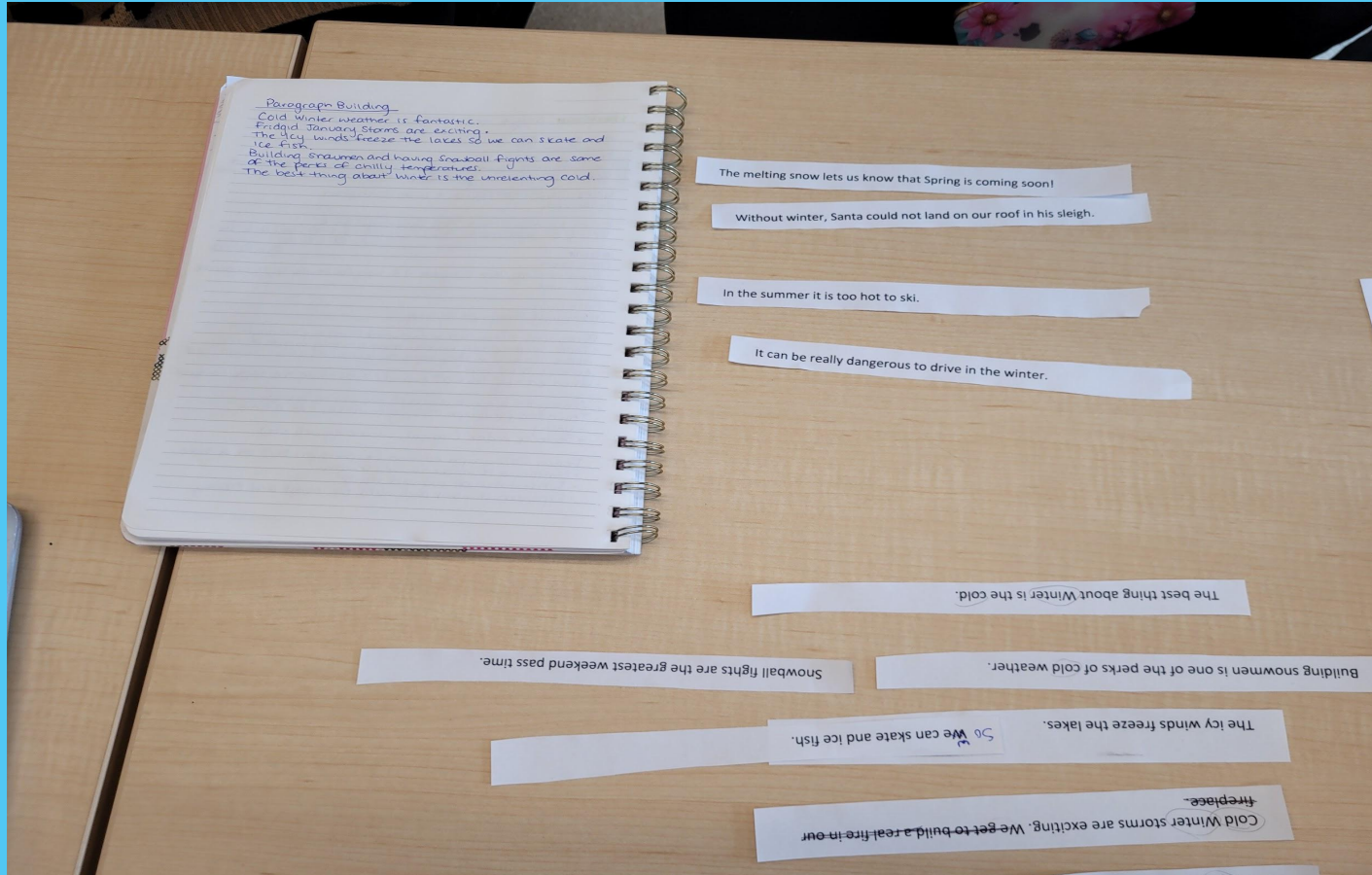


# Paragraph Building

# All About Books

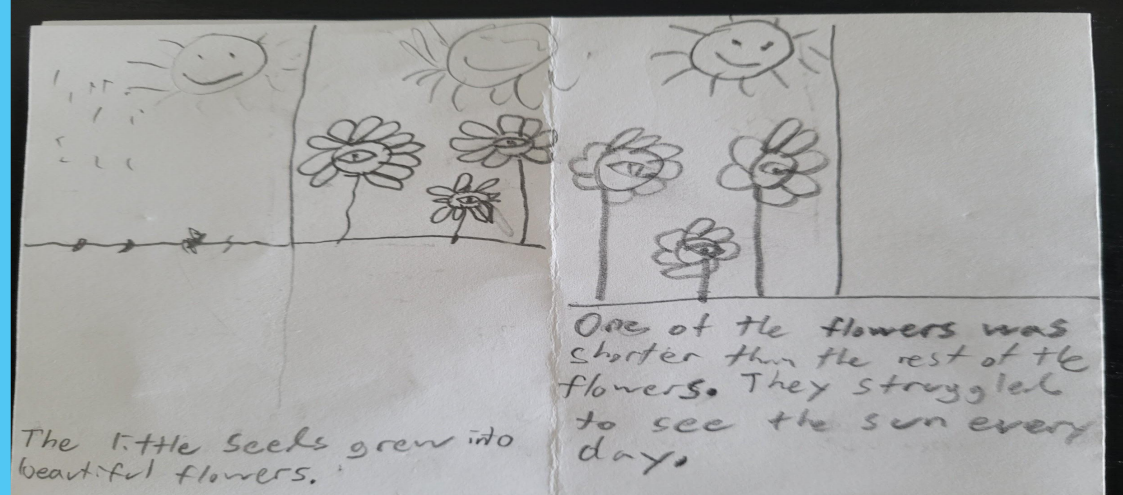
All about books is a creative way to introduce books to young students

The topics are typical nonfiction and familiar to the students

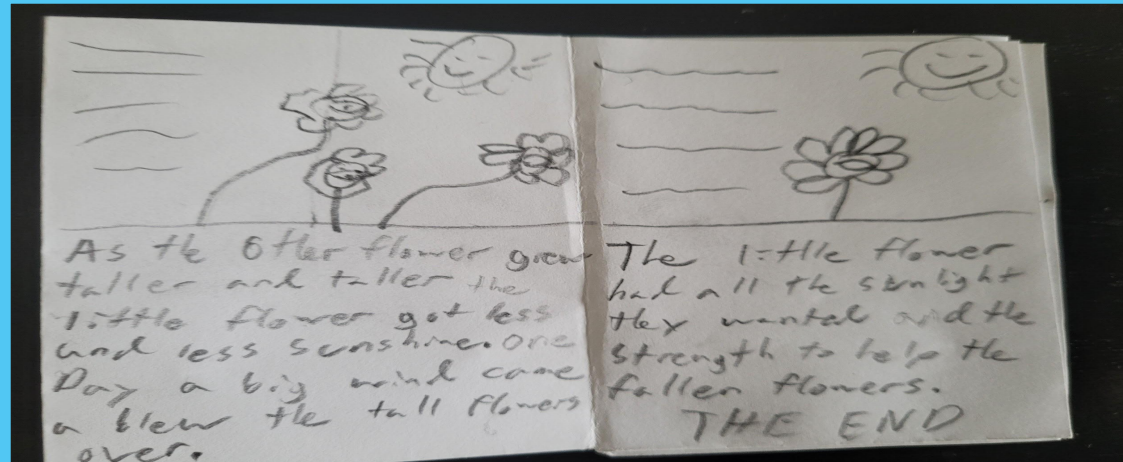


The Little Flower
